Cancer52 – published materials on rare and less common cancers

Cancer52 is an alliance of over 110 patient charities united in their vision of a better future for everyone affected by rare and less common cancers. We aim to promote improved diagnosis, treatment and support for those affected by rare and less common cancers.

Rare and less common cancers are defined as all cancers outside of the four most common cancers. There are over 200 different types of cancer, the majority of these are rare and less common cancers. In the UK, 47% of all cancer diagnoses and 55% of all cancer deaths are from rare or less common cancers. That means that every year around 180,000 people will be diagnosed from a rare or less common cancer and more than 92,000 people will die from a rare or less common cancer.¹

People with rare and less common cancers face unique and often ingrained challenges because of the broad scope of types of cancers, the diversity of rare and less common patient profiles including children and young people, and by definition, small patient populations. People with rare and less common cancers can experience inequalities in accessing care and treatment and face further inequalities linked with characteristics including deprivation, ethnicity, gender, age and disability.

These characteristics are associated with differences in prevalence of cancer risk factors, cancer incidence rates, experience of care and ultimately survival outcomes. Every cancer is different, but there are often shared challenges which affect people with rare or less common cancers including poorer patient experiences, delays to diagnosis and under investment. There can also be barriers to accessing specialist care and new, more effective, treatments.

This resource library brings together published materials from some of Cancer52's members to help NHS Community Connectors and others improve early diagnosis of rare and less common cancers, and ensure that patients can receive better support and more effective treatments.
